Page number	Changes for 2025 specification update
96	You don't need to know that the CPU architecture is known as the Von Neumann architecture.
104	Optical devices, CDs, DVDs or Blu-ray disks are no longer requirement of the specification.
105	The first section on optical discs is no longer required. You can also ignore the Optical column in the table.
110	You don't need to know star or bus LAN topologies or the following protocols: Ethernet, Wi-Fi, UDP, FTP or UDP.
113	The Ethernet and Wi-Fi protocols are no longer on the specification. However, you still need to know about wired and wireless networks.
115–116	You don't need to know about network topologies, the star topology or bus topology. However, you still need to know about PANs, LANs, WANs.
120	Ethernet protocol is no longer a requirement.
121	You don't need to know about Wi-Fi, but you do need to know about wireless LAN. You don't need to know about the User Datagram Protocol (UDP).
122	You need to know about the IMAP and SMTP protocols. You don't need to know about the POP protocol.
123	FTP and UDP protocols are no longer a requirement.
124	The following questions are no longer a requirement of the specification: 1(b-e) 5(b)(ii) For part (c) you don't need to know about UDP or FTP.
130	Q4 is no longer a requirement as you don't need to know about CDs or DVDs. However, if you understand what these are, the question is still relevant in understanding malware.
